When you turn in this Registration form to the Secretary, please be sure to have a copy of your FCC Amateur Radio Station License attached. The Secretary will then make two (2) more copies of all information and distribute one (1) to the “EC” and one (1) to the “RO” for further processing.

Registration does have some commitment to this organization as follows:

- 1.> Attending meetings on a regular basis.
- 2.> Maintain a minimum of required Training Courses.
- 3.> Participate in some of the functions that come up. (These are “Drills” and Community events which provide training.)
- 4.> Participate in various Radio Nets for information on what is happening.
- 5.> Keep in touch with the Officers of this Corporation as to your status, so that you are kept informed of meetings, drills and events.

This Organization holds one General Meeting each month, the second Wednesday, which may also include a Training Session. We also hold an ARES® Radio Net on 145.620 (-) (pl 100.0) every Wednesday evening, except the second Wednesday, at 1930 Hrs. local time for the checking of equipment and the dissemination of information of up-coming events.
